

AMGCC Auction Number 2

AMGCC auction number 2 consists of items from the collection of club President, Carl Scheriani. In addition to being the seller, Carl will serve as the Auction Director unless a permanent Auction Director is identified prior to the auction. All submitted E-mail bids should be sent to Carl at president@amgcollectors.org with a copy E-mailed to the journal editor, Richard Pederson, at editor@amgcollectors.org. Mail bids should be sent to Richard at P.O. Box 662, Clemson, SC 29633 USA. Richard will scan the mail bids and E-mail them to Carl so that both the acting Auction Director and Editor will have copies of all bids.

The closing date for this auction will be 11:59 PM on August 23, 2021. All E-mailed bids must be received by that cut-off date and time. All mailed bids must also be post marked by that date and time and received by the Editor no later than August 30, 2021. The following table, included on pages 15–21, lists

each available lot with the lot number, minimum/starting bid, and a brief lot description. Pictures of all lots will be posted on the AMGCC website, www.amgcollectors.org. A few lots are also pictured on the rear cover of this quarter's journal. A bid sheet, with the auction rules on the reverse is included as a separate insert with the current journal.

Please review the auction rules at the end of the auction listings as some rules have changed. Bids may be submitted on the bid sheet that is posted on-line. Bidders may also submit a printed bid sheet as long as it contains the desired lot numbers, bids for those lots, and is signed, dated, and includes the bidder's member number. Submission of any bid form, whether the one from the website or one created by the bidder, constitutes acceptance of the Auction Rules specified below.

The club still plans to auction the remaining items from the collection of Mike Maselli once they are received from the family. That is likely to occur in time for the third club auction which will be announced in the fourth quarter journal.

Auction Rules

1. All bids must be submitted by the announced auction cut-off date by mail or E-mail to the addresses listed on the auction bid sheet. Mailed bids must be postmarked and E-mailed bids must be time stamped on or before the cut-off date. Mailed bids must be received no later than seven calendar days after the cut-off date. There will be no Buyer's premium added to the sale price and the AMGCC is not responsible for bidder errors, omissions or failing to act on unclear bids.
2. In the event multiple bidders submit the same bid on a lot, the bidder with the earliest submission will be awarded the lot.
3. Bids must be placed using the following bidding increments: up to \$20, 50¢ increments; \$20.01–\$50, \$1 increments; \$50.01–\$100, \$2 increments; and over \$100, \$5 increments.
4. All bids over \$20 must be in even dollars using the above bidding increments. Bids not complying with the established increments will be adjusted down to the next lower increment.
5. All lots will be sold at one bidding increment over the second-highest bid. If a lot receives only one bid, it will be sold at the minimum (reserve) bid amount.
6. Only AMG-related material, including stamps, covers, literature, and ephemera, may be auctioned.
7. Only current AMGCC members in good standing may bid on or submit items to be auctioned.
8. Consignors are responsible for scanning lots, providing lot descriptions, establishing minimum bid (reserve) amounts (if any), and mailing the lots to the winning bidders. If no minimum bid is set, the minimum opening bid will be set at \$1. Descriptions shall list Condition and Centering for individual stamps and condition for multiples unless part of a large grouping, mixture, or collection.
9. The AMGCC Auction Director will collect bids, determine the winning bidder, invoice the winning bidders, and notify the AMGCC Treasurer and consignors of

the winning bid amounts.

10. Invoices will include the total for all lots won plus mailing costs. USPS mailing costs will be billed based on the combined weight of the lots, as follows: under one pound will be sent as a USPS First-Class package, with tracking; over one pound will be sent priority mail; and books/ references will be sent at the book rate, regardless of weight.
11. Winning bidders, once invoiced, will send payment to the Treasurer by check made out to the AMGCC. Payments may also be submitted via Paypal, but the bidder is responsible for including the Paypal fee with the payment. The Treasurer will issue payment to the consignors, after deducting a 10% fee that is retained by the club for running the auction.
12. The AMGCC will post each auction on the AMG website, include the lot descriptions in the *A.M.G. Courier*, and post prices realized on-line following each auction. Pictures of all lots will only be posted on the AMG website.
13. The consignor will not mail lots to winning bidders until notified by the club that payment, including Paypal fee (if applicable), has been received.
14. Accuracy of lot descriptions is the responsibility of the consignor. Winning bidders will be given the opportunity to return misdescribed lots unless they are large lots marked as "not returnable" or "as is". Bidders may also not return lots described as having faults because of those faults nor may they return lots because of faults readily visible in pictures in the auction listings displayed on the website.
15. The Auction Manager reserves the right to withdraw any lot prior to the sale.
16. Placing a bid or consigning an item for sale shall constitute full acceptance of these auction rules by the bidder and consignor.
17. All listed minimum bids and catalog values are in US dollars unless otherwise specified and all submitted bids must be in US dollars.
18. Bidders are expected to submit payment within 10 days of receiving an invoice. Failure to submit payments in a timely fashion may result in revoking the bidder's right to participate in future auction and/ or expulsion from the club.
